As an apprentice Early Years Lead Practitioner, gain expertise in maintaining children's safety, fostering inclusive practice, and leading key person roles. Develop skills in partnership working, managing the provision, and creating effective learning environments. The course covers promoting holistic development, wellbeing, and resilience, alongside leading assessment and planning. Prepare to champion best practices while inspiring and guiding teams to nurture children's growth, ensuring a thriving and supportive setting for every child.
